appointed Secretary of State and served under two governors until 1933.

While serving as chairwoman of many governmental and civic committees, she was especially proud of the fact that she was able to rescue and preserve an original copy of the Texas Declaration of Independence. In 1929 she published a book, *Women Pioneers*, which was inspired by her remarkable grandmother. She also wrote the Texas chapter in *National History of Woman Suffrage* and penned a weekly column for the Austin Statesman. She passed away on August 15, 1957.

In 1981 the McCallum House was purchased and beautifully restored by Roger and Nancy Danley. They sponsored the historical markers and converted it into one of the two bed and breakfasts in our neighborhood.




