## 1. Buckingham Square

Mark Perlmutter updated the association on the status of the case. Our case is set for October 16, 2006 for trial.

#### 2. Local and National Historic Districts

Laurie Limbacher received approval from attendees to ask the Texas Historical Commission to for a neighborhood assessment. The assessment is simply an assessment of the buildings in the neighborhood, not a designation. Association is also sending a letter to the City Council in support of local historic districts.

# 3. Traffic Report

Not much happening. Lindsay worked with the city to get "cross traffic does not stop" signs and paint on the road at a couple intersections along West. Discussion about a possible crosswalk at Wheatsville.

#### 4. No Parking
