1. Buckingham Square

Mark Perlmutter updated the association on the status of the case. Our case is set for October 16, 2006 for trial.

2. Local and National Historic Districts

Laurie Limbacher received approval from attendees to ask the Texas Historical Commission to for a neighborhood assessment. The assessment is simply an assessment of the buildings in the neighborhood, not a designation. Association is also sending a letter to the City Council in support of local historic districts.

3. Traffic Report

Not much happening. Lindsay worked with the city to get “cross traffic does not stop” signs and paint on the road at a couple intersections along West. Discussion about a possible crosswalk at Wheatsville.

4. No Parking

Discussion of putting up no parking signs near intersections where cars block the view of oncoming traffic. Traffic committee to identify areas for next meeting.

5. Heart Hospital Expansion

The Heart Hospital is looking to expand its building on the most western side of its structure. The Association has a small vote on whether or not to grant permission to expand. Discussion on how to make the expansion more pedestrian friendly.

6. Marimont Redevelopment

Capital One Bank looking to redevelop the Marimont site, but need a variance to put a drive-through at the location. Association is opposed to a drive through.

7. 35th Street

Not the Association's desire for property on 35th street to be occupied by college students.
